Once you are done, go to the Youth Services desk to get your sheet stamped. Finishing at least one row earns you a weekly prize! You may collect up to three weeks worth of prizes at a time.

For every row you complete (up to three), you also earn an entry ticket for one of several grand prizes. You can enter all your tickets in one prize or spread them out. It's up to you! The grand prize winners will be announced at the Summer Reading Party.
